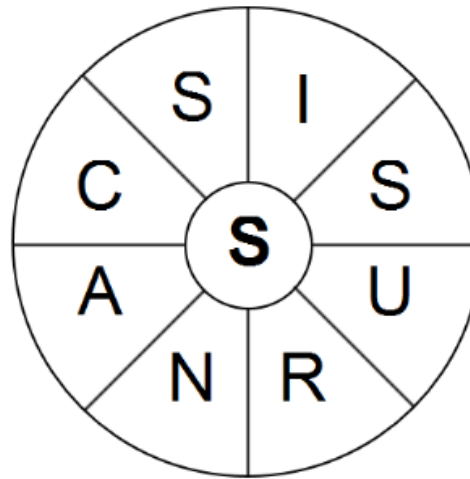


Fill in the grids so that each column, row, and box contains each of the four different colors: red, green, blue, and yellow.

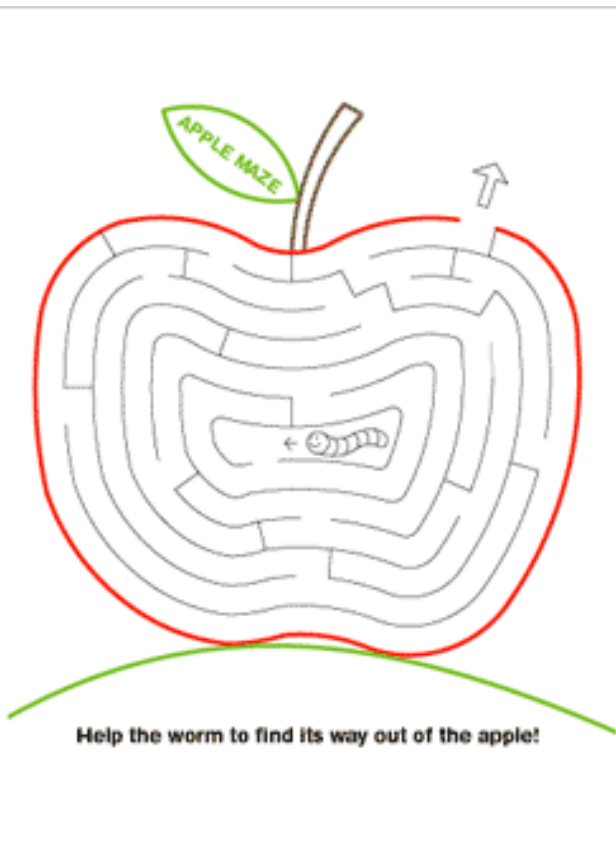

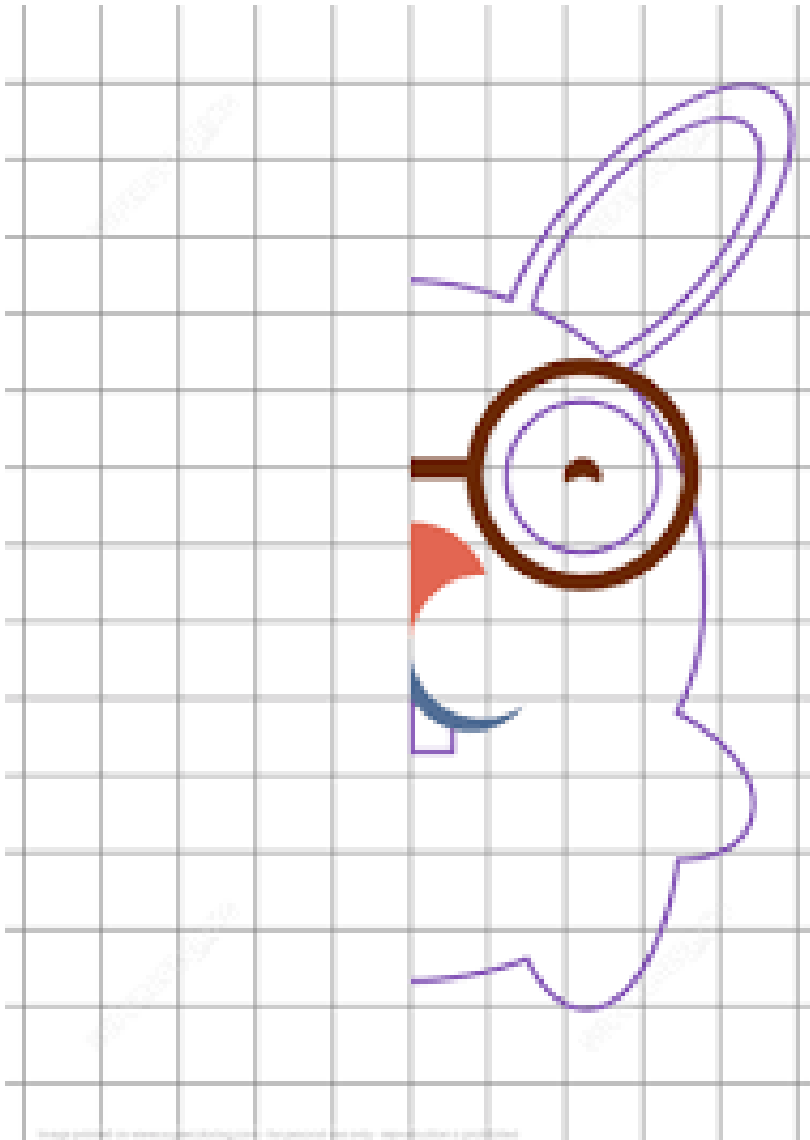
